
8th Grade Social Studies

Distance Learning


The beginning of the 2020-20201 school will begin in the Distance Learning Mode. Each student at SBWS is receiving an Apple iPad for their class lessons and assignments. Scholars are expected to utilize the iPad for completing all live lessons, meetings, and assignments.

All instruction will be live taught. Please make sure your scholars are logging into their classes on time. Refer to the class schedule for class start times on the previous page.

Assignment due dates are posted to each Assignment in Google Classroom. You will have access to your scholar's grades through the Parent Portal of JMC this year. Please make sure that you are looking into adding this app! Check with the office for further help!

*Additional Homework may be added during the school year, if work is not completed during the school day.

- This fall, scholars are expected to log in to each of their assigned classes by their start time. Like in school, classes will begin at scheduled time.
- Advisory begins at 9:00 A.M. daily.
 Attendance for the day begins
 during this time. If it helps to be
 up by these times, set an alarm on
 your iPad for a reminder to log in.
- Sharing your iPad Video. This fall we are requiring scholars to utilize their camera features during Zoom meetings. Last quarter, many scholars would log into meetings and leave their devices. With video settings on, teachers can ensure scholars are there for each lesson.
