As we celebrated Black History Month here at Stonebridge, students and staff created beautiful bulletin boards and door displays that decorated the hallways. Here are just a few:



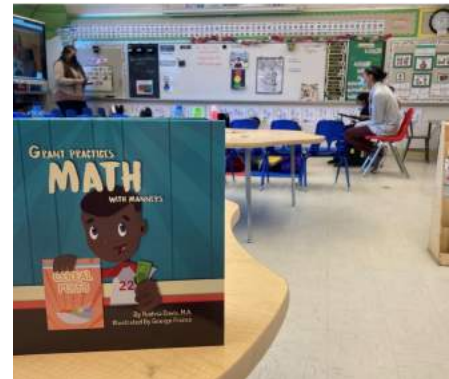
Drumming

Students also participated in a presentation led by Eric Childs. Eric is a professional graphic designer and the owner of [Mind's Eye Comics](#).

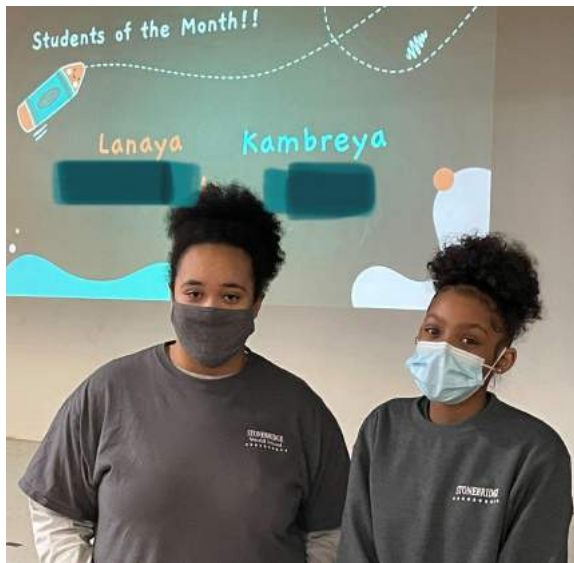


Robotics Club
