

STONEBRIDGE WORLD SCHOOL BOARD OF DIRECTORS
ELECTION PROCEDURES

Number of Directors

The board of directors shall consist of at least five (5) but not more than nine (9) unrelated voting members. Current membership includes: three (3) community members, two (2) licensed teachers (currently working at Stonebridge), one (1) parent or legal guardian (with student currently attending Stonebridge).

Terms of Office

Board of Directors will have staggered terms. Terms shall be for three (3) years commencing on July 1 following the election. If a vacancy becomes available prior to the end of a term of a board director an appointment is made to fill a vacancy and continues for the balance of the unexpired term.

No director shall serve more than eight (8) consecutive terms. A former director is eligible for re-election after one (1) year spent not serving on the board of directors.

Officers

The officers of the board shall consist of Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and such other officers as the board deems advisable. Officers shall be elected by the board for a one-year term.

Election procedures

Elections will be held annually in May.

Eligible voters are current staff members, current teachers, current board of directors, parents, legal guardians of current students. Any individual who falls in this category has the right to exercise one vote.

Individuals interested in serving on the board must submit a candidate biography to the current board chair. Biographies must include candidate's name, email, a brief background statement and interest in joining the board.

Candidate bio's will be posted on the website prior to the election.

Notice of the election will be posted on the school website and by others means.

Candidates' names and bio's will be posted on the website 10 days before the election.
